AGE of RIDER: As at Show Day.

ADMISSION: Membership Ticket (1 Member, 1 Adult & 2 Children) \$20.00. Payable with entry fees
Competitors (without membership ticket) will be charged admission at the gate. There will be no refunds.
Entry at Gate: Adults \$ 10.00 (16 years & Over)
Children \$ 5.00 (Primary School Children and under FREE)

JUDGING: Show Jumping is expected to commence at **9:00am**.

Carriage Driving classes will begin at the completion of all the flat classes – approx **12 noon**

Whilst every effort is made to be fair to all competitors, no classes will be delayed and no responsibility will be accepted for classes that clash.

SAFETY: All riders must wear a current Standards Approved safety helmet & proper riding boots.

DRUGS: Strictly Forbidden

SPECIAL NOTE: Exhibitors are required to have their Public Liability Insurance Policies ENDORSED to cover stock whilst being transported to & from the competition.

Rules and Regulations for Hacking Section

Please read all regulations carefully

- Flat classes are open to all entries.
- All riders **must** wear the current Standard Approved safety hat.

SADDLE CHAMPIONSHIPS First placegetters in all classes will be eligible for their respective Championship in each ring. The second placegetter(s) to the eventual Champion is also eligible for the Reserve Championship.

NOVICE DEFINITION Not to have won 3 Novice or 1 Open Class at any Show.

JUDGES may classify Lightweight and Heavyweight exhibitors in each section.

RIDING COMPETITIONS The Society reserves the right to combine, alter or delete any class as deemed necessary with the exception of all Height Classes

The age of each horse is to be calculated as from the 1st August. Every horse foaled before 1st August in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date. Saddle Exhibits must be 3 years and over.

In all classes where the age of the rider is stipulated, confirmation of age may be requested and date of birth should be stated on entry form. Age taken as at the day of the Show.

Cruelty to horse is forbidden. A competitor found guilty of committing a definite act of cruelty will be disallowed from taking part in all competition of the event where the offence was committed. This decision rests with the Society from which there is no further appeal.

DOPING It is forbidden to administer any stimulants or depressants to a horse or to cause one to be administered, in any way whatsoever, either before the start of a competition or on the previous day, under the maximum penalty of disqualification for life of the owner, rider, horse and groom.

WARNING: RANDOM SWABBING COULD TAKE PLACE

PROTESTS Any protest shall be lodged with the Secretary within one hour of the occurrence which gives rise to a complaint and be accompanied by a fee of \$50. The decision of the ground jury will be final in all matters.

Agricultural Show Council of Tasmania Inc and Wynyard Agricultural & Pastoral Society (together **the Suppliers**) advise that participation (including passive participation) in animal handling at an agricultural show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

1. By signing this waiver I acknowledge that:
 - 1.1 participation in animal handling is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the **Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010**, and also a recreational activity for the purposes of Section 19 of the **Civil Liability Act (2002) TAS**;
 - 1.2 participation in animal handling is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.3 participation in animal handling requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - 1.4 animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
 - 1.5 animal showing events will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals;
 - 1.6 if the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - 1.7 insects or other animals may cause animals to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
 - 1.8 there is inherent in events involving the handling of animals the risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by animals; and
 - 1.9 I use the facilities supplied for the event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
2. If I suffer injury, loss or damage (**Loss**) while participating in an animal handling event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any Loss I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided and/or activity I have participated in.
3. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the event and associated activities is dangerous and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur. I acknowledge that the event and associated activities carry with them a significant risk of physical harm. I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in regard to their negligence, breach of statutory duty or statutory guarantees arising from or in connection with these activities to the fullest extent permitted by law.
4. At the time of participating in the event, I have not been to any degree under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
5. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the Event and agree that such use may result in my being excluded from the Event or other events with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
6. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of the Agricultural Show Council of Tasmania Inc as varied from time to time.

REGULATIONS

1. A member's ticket (Cost: \$20.00) will admit the member, plus one adult & two children under 16 years of age.
2. No one, whether in charge of exhibits or otherwise, will be admitted without a ticket. A free ticket will be issued to an exhibitor with 3 animal & 2 passes with 7 or more animals exhibited & will only be issued on receipt of a STAMPED SELF ADDRESS ENVELOPE. For horses see horse schedule.
3. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
4. All exhibits must be in the yards by 9.00am on Show Day.
5. The age of Horses shall date from August 1 in each year &, for Cattle, from July 1 in each year.
6. Exhibitors must give where required, the correct date of birth of each animal entered.
7. ALL CALVES attached to cows shall NOT exceed the age of nine (9) months & the date of birth shall be shown on the Entry Forms.
8. All entries must be made on the correct Entry Form & lodged with the Secretary, on or before the closing date stated on the Schedule.
9. Professionals cannot enter Section J, other Sections open to all.
10. All implements, vehicles & machinery MUST be placed in the Showground before 9.30am on the day of the show.
11. Admission to pavilion for collection of Industrial Exhibits is by Special Pass ONLY (for protection of your exhibits) & ONLY after 4.00pm.
12. The Judges, upon entering the Showgrounds, shall proceed to the office of the Secretary. Accompanied by the Stewards for the particular Section or Class ect., they shall proceed to examine & decide upon the merits of the exhibits. Their inspection finished, they shall sign & give their reports to the Secretary, & their awards shall be final, unless a valid objection be raised against the prize takers in their respective classes.
13. In the event of the Judge considering that any of the Exhibitors have not complied with the conditions of the Show, the same may be disqualified. Judges are empowered to withhold the prize in any Class with the exhibit is deemed unworthy.
14. All protests must be lodged in writing with the Secretary on Show Day, within one half hour of the event or prior to 5.00pm.
Protests MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A \$10.00 DEPOSIT.
15. Protests, disputes or other matters arising at the Showground shall be dealt with by the Protest Committee forthwith. Should the protest be deemed frivolous, the deposit lodged shall be forfeited.
16. All horses must be ready to parade at 2.15pm & entrants must be ready to commence jumping at 8.30am.
17. The GRAND PARADE shall commence at 2.15pm. Exhibitors shall parade in such order as shall be directed by the officials in charge. No person will be allowed to remove & exhibit from the Showground before 3.00pm on Saturday without the consent of the Secretary & the appropriate Chief Steward. If exhibits are otherwise removed then any prize money awarded may be forfeited to the Society
18. The Society's Champion of Champions Award will be made to females in all Sections. Junior Champions from Cattle Classes two (2) years and under.
19. The Society reserves the right to substitute trophies or vouchers in lieu of cash prizes listed in the Schedules, provided that such trophy or voucher be of equal value to the prize offered. Trophies & vouchers shall be shown in the Schedules, as far as is possible.
20. All animals are to comply with Breed registration conditions & Breed Assoc. rules. All certificates issued ARE TO ACCOMPANY ANIMALS TO THE SHOW, & MUST be produced on demand. All animals MUST be NLIS identified in accordance with DPI regulations. Failure to comply will result in the animal(s) being disqualified forthwith.
21. Where an animal is entered in the name of a school or a student of that school, the entry form MUST show the name of the owner of such animal.
This regulation is not applicable to Handlers Classes.
22. JOHNE'S DISEASE: The society and its Insurers accept NO LIABILITY WHATSOEVER for any cattle or sheep which might be a source of infection or contagion to other cattle/sheep of entries.
23. The Committee reserves the right to restrict the number of entries per exhibitor, should the demand for space warrant it. Any such restrictions will be advised on close of entries.
24. In the event of any exhibit causing any damage or injury whatsoever, the owner/exhibitor or the person having control thereof, shall indemnify the Society & its Insurers against damages, injuries, costs, expense or liabilities incurred in connection with the same.
25. These regulations, together with the conditions printed in the appropriate schedule & the certificates signed by the owner/exhibitor on the completed entry form, are the basis of an exhibitor's entry into competition at the Wynyard Show and, as such are an agreement between the exhibitor & the Society as to the terms of entry and competition at the Wynyard Show.
26. EQUINE INFLUENZA: The Society & its Insurers accept NO LIABILITY WHATSOEVER for any horse or horses which may be a source of infection or contagion to any other animal nor for any illness which may occur to any horse or horses attending the Wynyard Show. Each & all riders/competitors/owners INDEMNIFIES the Society, its agents & its Insurers against any liability in relation to any horse which becomes infected with Equine Influenza virus whilst within the confines of the Frederick St Complex &/or the Wynyard Showground, whether competing or not.
