**ENTRIES:** ALL ENTRIES, other than cooking, vegetables and those in the Wynyard Garden Club section need to be delivered to the showgrounds on **WEDNESDAY 13<sup>th</sup> March between 4.00 and 5.00pm**. Entries for cooking and vegetables need to be delivered on **THURSDAY 14<sup>th</sup> March between 4.30 and 5.00pm**.

**JUDGING:** Judging will take place for entries on WEDNESDAY 13<sup>th</sup> March at 5:00pm and the cooking and vegetable sections will be judged from 5.00pm on THURSDAY 14<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

### Recipe

#### Chocolate Simplicity Cake

3 tablespoons butter  
2 level tablespoons cocoa  
½ cup milk  
1 cup sugar  
pinch salt  
1 cup S.R. flour  
2 eggs



Melt butter place all other ingredients in a large mixing bowl. Pour the melted butter over the ingredients and beat hard for 3 minutes. Place mixture in a suitable cake tin and bake in a moderate oven for approximately 25 minutes. When cool ice with chocolate icing.
